A BILL

To reduce gravity in order to address the growing trend of obesity and weight gain.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Obesity Reduction and
5 Health Promotion Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 The Congress finds as follows:

8 (1) Obesity and weight gain are a growing
9 trend in this Nation.

1 (2) Those who are obese or overweight are at
2 an increased risk for many diseases and health con-
3 ditions, including but not limited to high blood pres-
4 sure, osteoarthritis, type II diabetes, coronary heart
5 disease, and stroke.

6 (3) Medical professionals generally agree that a
7 reduction in weight would benefit everyone who is
8 overweight and lead to improvement in their overall
9 health.

10 (4) Obesity and weight gain are often caused by
11 caloric intake without sufficient exercise.

12 (5) Many Americans, including Members of
13 Congress, enjoy the many flavors, tastes, and types
14 of food offered in our great country.

15 (6) With schedules that are hectic and ever in-
16 creasing, many Americans, including Members of
17 Congress, have little time for healthy exercise.

18 (7) The combination of caloric intake, busy
19 schedule, sedentary profession, and lack of exer-
20 cise combine to result in an increase in weight in
21 many Americans, including Members of Congress,
22 expanding waistlines and bulges of various sizes and
23 shapes.

1 **SEC. 3. GRAVITY REDUCTION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Without exception and as applied
3 to all Americans, the force of gravity shall be reduced by
4 10 percent.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect im-
6 mediately upon enactment.
